

Seeking Fall Operations Interns

RedZone Football Academy is taking applications for 2024 fall internship positions. Duties for fall interns align primarily with RedZone's flagship program, the RedZone League flag football season. This will be the 11th RedZone League season, which is open to all local 1st-6th grade students and has grown to 800+ players and 50+ teams. The league hosts 30+ games per week; games are 3 nights per week. Games will occur primarily Napoleon Park in Iowa City though some satellite site games will occur. RedZone is owned and operated by University of Iowa football alum (2005-09) Tyler Blum; RedZone's main office is currently in North Liberty.

RedZone League Operations Intern up to 6 positions available

RZ League Ops Interns will assist in the administration of the RedZone League flag football season. Primary duties on game days will include gameday setup/tear down, serving as a field monitor that keeps score, time, player usage stats, and records results, and officiating games on days we're short staffed. There may be additional duties necessary before/during/after the season which may include (but is not limited to) equipment preparation, season administration, end-of-season duties, or marketing projects.

<u>Term:</u> Fall; August 1 – December 1. Preferred to start as close to August 1 as possible, but willing to accept start dates as late as August 20.

<u>Schedule:</u> Must be available on Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday evenings (generally 5-9pm) between the dates of August 28 – October 20. There may additional hours needed beyond these game nights to meet the fulfillment requirement. Those hours can be more flexible.

Fulfillment Requirement: 135 hours

<u>Course Credit:</u> This internship is available for course credit for UISRM majors. It is preferred that interns apply This internship to UISRM course credit but not required.

Pay: This internship is unpaid

All applicants can expect to have an interview with Tyler Blum at RedZone in person or via Zoom.

To apply, please submit a resume and a statement answering these 3 questions:

What is your dream job?

What is it that makes you stand out? What are you better at than your colleagues or other applicants?

Will you be applying this internship for course credit? If yes, please list the major or program you're looking to apply credit for.
